R U L E S

1. Entrants are asked to refer to the Mission and Vision of the Norfolk Historic Buildings Trust ('the Trust') when considering their design. The Trust is looking for a logo which suitably conveys an idea of the work it undertakes. Entrants should also look at the current website www.norfolkhistoricbuildingstrust.org.uk for more information on its work, but bear in mind that this is to be replaced with a new website very soon.

MISSION

The conservation and promotion of Norfolk's built heritage.

VISION

Norfolk Historic Buildings Trust achieves its mission by being:

A CATALYST for building conservation initiatives, working in partnership with others.

A CHAMPION for conservation through campaigning, fundraising and raising public awareness of its work.

A CUSTODIAN for important buildings where no independent, economic and sustainable use exists.

2. The winner agrees to legally assign copyright of the winning design to the Norfolk Historic Buildings Trust, free from all encumbrance, financial or copyright demands and the Trust will be free to reproduce the logo in whatever medium or form it wishes, in perpetuity. The winner will be fully credited on the Trust's new website, unless they inform the Trust in writing they wish not to be.
3. Submissions can be in any medium or format although the Trust reserves the right to reject any deemed too difficult to reproduce.
4. Submissions can be of any size as long as the quality is sufficiently good to reproduce in a variety of sizes and media. It is anticipated that the logo will be used on letterhead, leaflets, website, banners, and more.
5. Entrants may submit as many designs as they wish.
6. All entrants must include their name, postal address, email address and at least one telephone number with their submissions. The Trust reserves the right to reject any submissions without this information.
7. Submissions should be clearly labelled 'logo competition' and emailed to nhbt@btconnect.com or posted to Norfolk Historic Buildings Trust, The Old Church,
St. Matthews Road, Norwich NR1 1FP.
8. The closing date is strictly midnight on Monday 31st October 2016.

9. The judges' decision is final.
10. The winner will be notified and awarded £500 prize money sometime after Monday 14th November 2016 but no later than Monday 21st November 2016.
11. The winner agrees to freely partake in any suitable publicity as requested by the Trust.
12. The Trust reserves the right not to award any prize or declare any winner if none of the entries are considered suitable for the Trust's purposes.
13. No postal submissions will be returned without a correctly sized, stamped and addressed envelope being included.
